I have another guy coming by tomorrow that I trust. The chimney was relined last year. Which position does the switch have to be in for updraft and or downdraft. If the boiler will be shut off, I would suggest not piping the electric tank thru the coil. And if you ever need a new boiler, it will cost that much less not having the tankless coil feature. Too bad the heating system is new, if it wasn't and gas was available, I would suggest converting it to gas. Should the price of installing a 40 gallon compared to a 60 gallon be a huge difference. Any heat in the piping should not migrate past the check valve, or flow check. Does anyone have any suggestions on how to fix this. Once I bottom out the knob to hot, it sometimes gets cold, and sometimes I let it run and the burner comes on and it gets hot again. You can then redo it on your own schedule the way you want to. If there's more than one layer the weight of the shingles are going to make the expensive to dispose of, you're no longer disposing of one roof but two. With a tank, the boiler only fires when the tank or the heating system calls for heat. Still doesn't change the fact that the mode of operation is summer winter hookup water heater inefficient during summer but you could install electric heater in series with boiler as standby or extra back up during heavy demand but would increase standby losses during non heating summer mode. When I bought my house the former owners had the boiler hooked up with a summer winter hookup. Some shingles are coming off in front on the one side. You are effectively heating the boiler with the electric water heater. If you have any problems with the registration process or your account login, please. We did not tie the heat in though. Is it as simple as valving the baseboards off at the furnace or do I need to do additional adjustments. It has an addition that put on in 1930. Would it make sense to convert to electric hot water heat? I can't tell just by standing beneath it. There's a difference between a summer-winter hookup with a coil, and one that uses a tank of some sort. Too bad the heating system is new, if it wasn't and gas was available, I would suggest converting it to gas. You can also shut down the boiler for the summer, but this may cause leaks at the fittings, which will shorten the life of the boiler.
